Trade Department Circular

United Nations Sanctions Regulations

It is announced for general information that on 2 July 1999 the Government gazetted :

- (i) United Nations Sanctions (Libya) (Suspension of Operation) Regulation 1999 (L.N.173 of 1999); and
- (ii) United Nations Sanctions (Libya) (Prohibition of Flights) (Suspension of Operation) Regulation 1999 (L.N.174 of 1999).

These two Regulations are made under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) by the Chief Executive on the instruction of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and after consultation with the Executive Council.

2. The purpose of these two Regulations is to suspend the operation of the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) Regulation and United Nations Sanctions (Libya) (Prohibition of Flights) Regulation (Cap. 537 sub. leg.) as the Security Council of the United Nations has suspended the sanctions against Libya.
