Completion of an Import Notification (Textiles)

In completing an Import Notification (Textiles), a registered textiles trader must state the intended end use of the imported textiles in the *End Use* column. The most common types of end use are :

- (a) Local sale to consumers through retail outlets
- (b) Local sale to consumers through hawkers
- (c) Local sale to consumers through our company
- (d) Local sale/supply to (please give company name and company address)
- (e) Re-export to (please give country name)
- (f) Manufacture into complete garment by (please give company name and company address)
