

**Proposed Label Information under the Product Safety Standards (Children's Nightwear and Limited Daywear Having Reduced Fire Hazard) Regulations 2005**

Category	Description	Fire hazard information label
1	Garments made from fabric of the low fire hazard type and which comply with Section 1	<b>LOW FIRE DANGER</b>
2	Garments made from fabric which does not comply with Section 1 but which are designed to reduce fire hazard and which comply with Section 2	<b>CAUTION</b> NOT HEAT OR FLAME RESISTANT WEAR SNUG-FITTING TO REDUCE RISK
3	All-in-one garments made predominantly from knitted fabrics, in Sizes 00 to 2, which comply with Section 3	<b>CAUTION</b> NOT HEAT OR FLAME RESISTANT WEAR SNUG-FITTING TO REDUCE RISK
4	Garments which do not comply with Sections 1 to 3, but which comply with Section 4	<b>WARNING</b> HIGH FIRE DANGER KEEP AWAY FROM FIRE 

The wording shall be clearly legible in upper case, monoline, geometric lineale typeface of medium width characters not less than 2.5 mm high. The word 'caution' shall be in bold, upper case, typeface.

The wording on labels for Category 2 and 3 garments shall be black on an orange label. The words may appear on more than one line.

The orange label colour shall be marigold, as specified in AS 2700 or light orange as specified in NZS 7702.
