

**AUSTRALIA-HONG KONG FREE TRADE AGREEMENT
ANNEX 13-A
NOTIFICATION OF ADJUSTED THRESHOLD VALUES**

As required by Annex 13-A, Section H, of the Australia-Hong Kong Free Trade Agreement, Australia hereby notifies Hong Kong of the adjusted threshold values in Australian dollars (AUD), which are effective from 1 January 2022:

Central Government Entities (Section A)	AUD256,000 for procurement of goods and services, and AUD9,861,000 for procurement of construction services
Sub-Central Government Entities (Section B)	AUD700,000 for procurement of goods and services, and AUD9,861,000 for procurement of construction services
Other Entities (Section C)	AUD789,000 for procurement of goods and services, and AUD9,861,000 for procurement of construction services

The calculation of the thresholds is based on the average of the daily value of AUD in terms of the Special Drawing Rights (SDR) over the period from October 2019 to September 2021 (SDR 1 = AUD 1.972197901).

The next adjustment of the threshold values will be made in two years and become effective on 1 January 2024.
