In this respect, I have the honour to confirm the agreement reached by the Free Trade Commission under the Agreement, pursuant to Article 11.10 and Article 16.1.3 (b) of the Agreement, on updating the text of Annex 11.6 of Chapter 11 (Trade in Services) of the Agreement, and to propose its replacement by the text set forth in the Appendix to this letter.

I have the further honour to propose that this letter and your letter of confirmation in reply shall constitute an agreement between the Government of the Republic of Chile and the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China, which, according to Article 19.2.2 of the Agreement, shall enter into force 90 days after the date of the last notification by which the Parties inform each other that the necessary domestic legal procedures have been completed.
